Wyoming City Council Vacancy! Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 362.3 the Wyoming City Council intends to fill the vacancy by appointment at the November 8, 2022, regular meeting of the Wyoming City Council which commences at 7:00 p.m. The electors of Wyoming have the right to file a petition requiring that at the vacancy be filled by election. The petition must contain the signature and address of at least 10 eligible electors of Wyoming and be filed with the City Clerk no later than fourteen (14) days after the appointment is made or fourteen (14) days after the date of publication of this notice, whichever is later. If a legal petition is filed, the Council will call a special election as prescribed by the Iowa law and the appointment shall be temporary until the results of the special election are canvassed and the successful candidate is duly qualified.




