The Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) will host its 22nd **National Prescription Drug Take Back Day** on Saturday, April 30th from 10 am to 2 pm. This bi-annual event offers free, anonymous disposal of unneeded medications at more than 4,000 local drop off locations. Locally, drop off sites are: Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Maquoketa Police Department in Maquoketa; Linn County Sheriff's Office at Springville Fire Station; Cedar County Sheriff's Office at the Cedar County Law Center in Tipton; and the Mt. Vernon/Lisbon Police Department. Nightingale Drug in Wyoming also accepts various pharmaceuticals on a regular basis. Please check with them as to specific items taken or not. According to Chief Deputy Brian Eckhart of the Jones County Sheriff's Office, prescription drugs are also accepted on a daily basis at their office. As with any of the collection locations, there are restrictions on what can be accepted.
