On Tuesday, traffic control lights were installed in front of the Lutheran Church and up the hill to the other side of the County Road to the south. The intersection is closed to the south and north on State Street. Excavation began Wednesday to repair the storm sewer crossing the highway from North to South.

The street and sidewalk projects are DOT projects and are funded by the DOT. Sidewalk removal and reinstallation will begin soon and highway surfacing will be done later.
