From the Midland Times – September 19, 1986. An air compressor explosion rocked Wyoming Sept 12, seriously injuring a Wyoming man in his garage. Lorenz (Junior) Brodersen was changing tires on his pickup truck with a pneumatic jack supporting the rear end of the truck. He had an air wrench connected to the air hose when the air pressure stopped. He went to investigate and was standing on a ladder beneath the compressor when the explosion occurred blowing him off the ladder. Two arteries in his left arm were severed and his face and chest were splattered with debris. He was taken to the Maquoketa Hospital and transferred by helicopter to Iowa City.

City of Wyoming Sidewalk Program. Over the years an increasing number of sidewalks have become defective. To encourage property owners to make necessary repairs the City will provide 100% of the cost of the concrete for existing public sidewalks only. Property owners are responsible for labor, including forms. This program will be applicable to residential property owners only. A cap of \$750 per applicant applies. Upon approval, the property owner may submit his/her itemized bill for the cost of the concrete needed for the project.

The City will reimburse the property owner's cost of concrete following the next City Council meeting. The City will not pay the contractor.
