#### **Highway construction and detours:**

Hwy 136 – due to sewer work in the town of Oxford Junction, Hwy 136 from Wyoming will be closed soon. Detour signs are being posted. Only that portion of the highway in Oxford Junction will be affected by the construction. This project is expected to take several months. Signage directs traffic to be rerouted to Maquoketa on Hwy 64 and then back west on 136 to Oxford Junction. Alternate routes are available.

Hwy 64 – between Wyoming and Monmouth – this project will involve milling and overlay of the present road, tiling of the shoulder, and the addition of a 4' paved shoulder. The initial work will be prep work with some delay of traffic. Final surfacing work will involve traffic control and pilot vehicles. Work is scheduled to start about May 1st, but may start anytime.
