Highway 64 project – 5 inches of asphalt has been milled off and reapplied with 4-foot extensions. Work has begun at Monmouth on the 2 inch second or intermittent layer of new asphalt. Approximately 2 miles of the second layer are done. When that is complete another 2-inch top coat of new asphalt will be applied to complete the project.

Highway 136 project - As the detour signs have been posted for about a month and little has been done on the City of Oxford Junction project, the DOT has come to an agreement with the contractor that the signs will be covered until work begins and only uncovered while work is in process. It was reported that some work was to resume on the 26th.

New Highway Signs – The DOT will be replacing all traffic signs on Highway 64 this summer from Anamosa to Sabula.
